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SCHOLARSHIPS

There are various Scholarships offered at Mabel Park State High School and these are aimed at exceptional students within their field of speciality. Scholarships on offer in 2023:

- Academic Scholarship
- iMPact Scholarship
- Maths Science Academy (MSA) Scholarship

- Community Scholarship

The Application Package must be completed and returned to Mabel Park State High School Administration with all relevant documentation attached (copies of report cards) by no later than Week 10 of Term 1 in 2023.

Please note Scholarships are valid for a period of 12 months **ONLY**. Recipients must re-apply each year and must demonstrate their commitment to the program and meet all of the required standards.

With each Scholarship comes student responsibilities (as per scholarship conditions & student contract). If a student fails to maintain their commitment to their program and/or the required standards of performance, the scholarship can be revoked at any stage throughout the course of the year.

Successful recipients' performance and behaviour will be reviewed by the scholarship panel regularly. Scholarship recipients not meeting the program requirements will be at risk of losing their scholarship status, and will be notified in writing. Recipients will have an opportunity to put forward a personal statement of support to this panel before any final decision to revoke the Scholarship is made. Recipients and parents will be notified of the outcome.

All Scholarship recipients should maintain 95% or above school attendance. All Scholarship recipients should maintain a minimum of B standard or higher in Behaviour and Effort across all Subject Areas.

In the event that you leave either Mabel Park State High School or the Program of Excellence, Mabel Park State High School reserves the right to invoice you for any costs incurred on your behalf including but not limited to school fees, academy fees, instrumental music levies and uniform costs.

If your Scholarship is revoked, you will be invoiced at a pro-rata rate for any costs no longer covered by your Scholarship. Please note that NO entitlements will be available prior to the 2023 school year, and without the signed paperwork and application being returned.



ARTS ACADEMY SCHOLARSHIP

The Arts Academy is offered as part of the curriculum at Mabel Park State High School. Talented students with a strong musical, dance or artistic ability are identified or self-nominated and after successful application are placed within the program. Applicants may be required to audition to become part of the program or submit a portfolio (if relevant). Audition dates will be published via our Facebook Page – Mabel Park State High School. Additional extra-curricular activities are offered to advance students’ learning beyond the classroom.

The Arts Academy Scholarship can be broken down into the following categories:

- Instrumental Music (Drumline, Strings, Band and Choir)
- Dance
- Drama
- Visual Art

Conditions - Visual Arts

- Take part in the High Performance Art program (Year 7-9).
- Attend weekly fine art and/or ceramics lesson after school.
- Involvement in school-based art projects.

Application Process (VISUAL ARTS)

Application packages are delivered to local primary schools and promoted internally and externally from Mabel Park State High School.

- 1. School Nomination** - Students who have previously received Scholarships are invited to re-apply each year. Offers will be made to students in Term 4 of 2021. Student & Parents/Carers receive the application package documentation.
- 2. Application Package** - Students and Parents/Carers must complete the Application Package and submit to Mabel Park State High School - Main Administration by Week 10 of Term 1. Applications may also be submitted by email to thearts@mabelparkshs.eq.edu.au. Applications will be accepted outside of these timeframes for exceptional students entering the Mabel Park State High School Community during the school year. When submitting the Application Package you must include:
 - Student Personal Details Form**
 - Most recent Report Card**
 - Student Contract (signed by student and parent)**
 - Folio submission (see below for more details)**
- 3. Assessment** – MPSHS scholarship panel will assess the application submission.
- 4. Student Notification** – Successful applicants will be formally accepted to participate in their selected Scholarship and will confirm acceptance by completing the enrolment process at Mabel Park State High School.

Please note all Scholarships are for the period of 12 months ONLY. All previous recipients must re-apply. Scholarship Leaders (allocated MPSHS staff) review scholarship recipients' data and progress to determine recipient suitability to re-apply.

To re-apply, a student would need to demonstrate their commitment to program and/or meet the required standards. For students who wish to re-apply - Please complete the written application and submit to the main Administration Office.
