Program Overview

In 2026, the Mabel Volleyball Program will support 55 students from Year 7 through to Year 12. The program was established in 2020 with a group of 10 students with the goal of encouraging young women to engage in sport, particularly students who may not have been involved in traditional high-performance pathways but still had a passion for competition, teamwork and personal growth. Originally, the program was designed to use volleyball as a vehicle to improve student engagement, attendance and behaviour.

In 2020, the average attendance rate of students in the program was approximately 70%, with around 40% of students failing at least one subject. In 2026, students involved in the program are now consistently achieving attendance rates above 90%, with approximately 90% passing all subjects and many excelling academically. The program operates through structured before and after-school training sessions. Students from different year levels train together, creating an environment where younger athletes are challenged to rise to the standard of older students, while senior students are given meaningful opportunities to develop leadership, responsibility and mentoring skills.

Our three core values are:

Team First

We represent MP State first and foremost. Our actions, effort and attitude reflect our school and our program.

Holistic Development

Growth on the court supports growth off the court. The lessons students learn through volleyball are applied to their schooling, relationships and everyday life.

Continuous Improvement

Students are encouraged to strive to become 1% better each day, both as athletes and as people.

Girls Volleyball Academic Success

In 2025, our athletes continued to demonstrate outstanding commitment to both their education and volleyball, achieving excellence both on the court and in the classroom. It is an expectation of our student athletes that they continue to maintain high standards across their academic achievements while participating in the program.

2025 Volleyball students' key academic outcomes included:

- Average school attendance of 93% across program participants
- 0 student suspensions
- 97.5% of students passed all core subjects (Mathematics, English, Science, Humanities)
- 4 students received Academic Awards for Excellence in School Service
- 11 students achieved Academic Excellence Awards (A average across 4+ subjects; no grade below a B)
- 3 senior students (Years 10–11) received subject awards for the highest achievement in their subject area
- 3 students received Specialist Academic Awards recognising both their leadership and academic excellence
