

# Investing for Success

## Under this agreement for 2017

Mabel Park State High School will receive

**\$520,785\***

### This funding will be used to

- Improve the transition of students from Primary school to High. This will be "in-built" through the vehicle of the Junior Secondary Transition Initiative targeting STEM and LOTE.
- Increase the number of students moving into full-time study and work.
- Improve Reading Levels of all students (NMS% Yr 7 – 90%, Yr 9 – 90%)
- Improve attendance levels by 3% across the whole school from 88% to 91%. Improve Indigenous student's attendance levels by 5% from 81% to 86%.

### Our initiatives include

- Continue to drive Positive Behaviour for Learning as the culture as Mabel Park SHS and continue to improve attendance
- Work intensively with the local feeder primary schools (Mabel Park SS, Woodridge North SS, Harrisfields SS and Daisy Hill SS) to ensure seamless transition to High School. The area of focus for this transition is STEM incorporating Coding and Robotics
- Target the differentiation of Reading with the key strategies of: Text dependant questioning, Tier 2 & 3 vocab, Reading to Learn and Tracking. This will entail intense Professional Development of all teachers.
- Focus on Upper 2 band READING strategies with faculties to target students capable of achieving U2B reading
- Continue to improve industry links to ensure students transition into full-time study or full-time work

### Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employ a Full-time teacher to work with local Primary Schools to improve transition to High School - \$70,000
- Employ a full-time specialist literacy Teacher to extend students - \$70,000
- Employ staff including Indigenous Liaison Officer, Teacher Aides and Administration Officers to enhance the Positive Behaviour for Learning Program - \$110,000
- Develop a whole school Peer Instructional Coaching Program including Professional Development and Teacher Resources - \$210,000
- Employ an Industry Liaison Officer to ensure successful pathways for Senior Students - \$60,000
