To develop a differentiated program to cater to student's needs which will support Year 9 students to achieve:

- 58% to 65% of students achieving at or above the National Minimum Standards in Writing.
- 2% to 7.5% of students achieving in the upper two bands for Reading.
- 86% to 90% of students achieving at or above the National Minimum Standards in Numeracy.

Our strategy will be to

Commit to Quality Teaching:

- Foster excellence in teaching and learning through instructional coaching to improve the delivery of literacy and numeracy outcomes.
- Provide quality time for Professional Learning Teams to meet and determine students' strengths and weaknesses and develop strategies to support and challenge students to strive for improvement.
- Differentiate student learning experiences based on triangulated data (NAPLAN, level of achievement and diagnostic data).
- Professionally develop staff capacity to deliver Reading to Learn, literacy and numeracy strategies.
- Embed Reading to Learn strategies throughout all learning areas.
- Embed whole-school literacy and numeracy strategies across all learning areas.

Develop Successful Learners:

- Consistently monitor student progress and levels of achievement through the Level of Achievement Monitoring Framework to provide feedback to students.
- Increase students' ownership of their results and set goals for improvement every 5-6 weeks.
- Build student test resiliency and examination skills through Mighty Minds practice.
- Foster a positive school environment through the Positive Behaviour for Learners framework to improve student engagement and self-efficacy.
- Continue to implement the attendance policy and work with students and families to meet our 95% attendance target.
- Celebrate student progress and successes in a variety of ways including Community into the Classroom events and Parent and Community Engagement Evenings.
