Character – essential qualities of the individual including: grit, tenacity, perseverance, resilience, reliability, and honesty



Citizenship - thinking like global citizens, considering global issues with genuine interest in engaging with others to solve complex problems



Collaboration - the capacity to work interdependently and synergistically in teams with strong Interpersonal and team-related skills



Communication - mastery of three fluencies: digital, writing, and speaking tailored for a range of audiences

Creativity - having an 'entrepreneurial eye' for economic and social opportunities, asking the right questions, and demonstrating leadership



Critical Thinking - evaluating information and arguments, seeing patterns and connections, construction meaningful knowledge and applying it in the real world

In order to achieve the 6 Global competencies above, students must commit to displaying high levels of effort, behaviour, attitude and attendance.

Students not committed to these high expectations will be placed in a probationary period with a plan codeveloped to demonstrate improvements. If students are unable to make those improvements they will be removed from the program to an alternative learning pathway at Mabel Park SHS.

Once you have understood the above concepts, please discuss with your parents/care givers and sign the declaration below. This must be returned to your iMPact STEM teacher by the end of Week 1, 2024.
